The 9 Pillars of Civility promoted by the Georgia Municipal Association (GMA) emphasize respectful and constructive communication.

- 1. Be considerate of others' opinions. It's perfectly acceptable to agree to disagree.
- 2. **Manage your emotions.** Instead of getting furious, cultivate curiosity.
- 3. A silent voice is not always weak. Sometimes, it's okay not to respond.
- 4. **Be kind!** Focus on discussing the issue, not attacking the person.
- 5. Actively listen. Engage respectfully and learn from others.
- 6. Think about the impact of your actions, not just the intent.
- 7. **Ask questions to learn.** Respond to questions with respect.
- 8. Remember QTIP (Quit Taking It Personal).
- 9. **Have empathy!** Just because you haven't experienced something doesn't mean it doesn't exist.
