PICK - UP: Artwork must be picked up on **April 23** -11 am - 4 pm or **April 25** - 10 am - 1 pm. Artwork not picked up by 4pm on May 23 will be disposed or sold, as we do not have room to store artwork.

ENTRY RULES:

- 1. Exhibit is for children ages 4-18 from Polk County or students who have taken RCAC classes or camps during the past year.
- 2. Student may submit **ONE** piece of art work that was completed in the past year.
- 3. There is no entry fee for this student show.
- 4. The artwork must be the **student's original work** and may be in 2 or 3 dimensional media.
- 5. Maximum size for 2-D work is 12" x 18". Maximum size for 3-D work is 12" x 12" x 18"
- 5. Use the age when student completed the artwork on the form.
- 6. Artwork may be completed at school, home, at a class or camp, however all artwork must be entirely made by the student.
- 7. The following are **NOT allowed**: No computer generated art; No ruled lined paper; No tracing; No copyrighted images, such as Disney characters, etc.
- 8. Artwork must be family friendly.
- 9. Artwork must be **matted**, **mounted or framed** and properly wired to hold the weight of the artwork, and ready for hanging. A limited number of free frames have been donated. Pick soon to see if your artwork will fit one of the frames.
- 10. A professional judge from out of Polk County will be selected for the judging.
- 11. The art entry, form, and label must be delivered on the delivery dates above and filled out correctly.
- 12. Student and Parent/Guardian must be present at the Reception/Award Ceremony.
- 13. If artwork is listed for sale, the gallery retains 20% commission and a check for 80% of the sale will be mailed after the exhibit. Buyers will take possession of the work at the end of the exhibit.
- 14. Security will be provided, however RCAC, The City of Rockmart, and Polk County will not be held responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- 15. Images may be used for the purpose of publicity in print or on the Internet by RCAC.
- 16. Winning students will have group photos taken for the RCAC Facebook, website and newspaper after the award ceremony. *Sponsored by RCAC, City of Rockmart and our Patrons* **Thank you!**
