Beginning Quilting - Tools & Techniques *with Dora Dryden*

September 14 - 10 am - 2 pm, \$25 per person, Ages 12 to Adult

Bring a sack lunch and water bottle.

If you want to try your hand at the traditional and also modern craft of quilting, this introductory class of basic quilt construction is for you. You will learn techniques for planning, cutting, and construction of a basic quilt block as well as skills in selecting fabrics and materials. Emphasis will be placed on accuracy in cutting and sewing to insure your quilt comes together perfectly. Students will complete a sample block.

You should be able to operate a basic sewing machine and sew a straight stitch.

You do not have to know anything about quilt construction.

Beginning Quilting Supply List:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Thread in a neutral color such as white or cream (50 wt. recommended)
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter (45 mm recommended) such as Olfa or Fiskars
- Straight pins and pincushion
- Scissors
- Acrylic ruler (6" x 12" recommended) such as Omnigrd
- 1/4" foot for your machine if you have one but is not required

Machine Applique Supply List:

- Sewing machine with variable zigzag stitch
- Scissors, pins, and seam ripper
- Neutral thread for bobbin
- 1/2 yard neutral background fabric for front

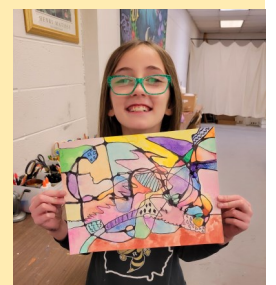

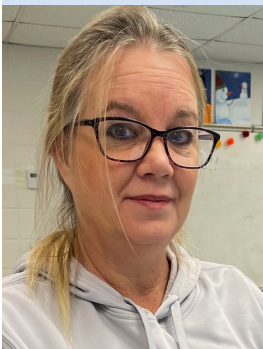

* Hypertufa is a lightweight, material made from a mixture of peat moss, Portland cement, and either sand, vermiculite, or perlite. After mixing the ingredients together, they are molded into shape, allowed to dry, and then may be painted.

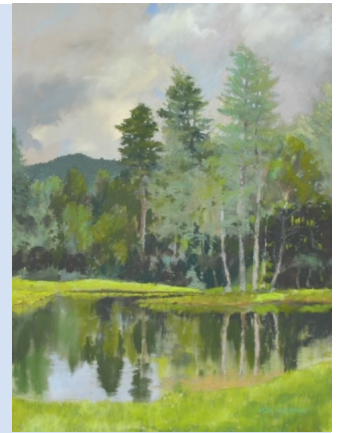

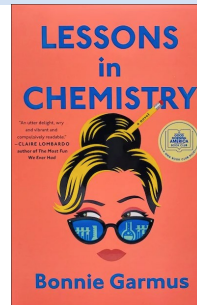
