From the Juror, Scott Foxx:

"It was my pleasure to adjudicate the annual Juried Competition for your art association.

The variety of media and subject was very impressive, and it was difficult to choose the winners. I am often asked how one makes judgements of art works when the media is so varied. My response is that I begin with the foundations of all artistic disciplines which are the fundamental elements and principles of design. No matter the media all art rests upon the use of composition, color, line, balance, unity and so forth. Next in my criteria is the relationship of form to content, originality, and a final element of creative audacity, something that surprises and delights the viewer. Balancing these qualities within each artwork, in the vernacular of their media, and then against one another, minimizes emotional preferences in favor of more academic assessment.

Thank you for trusting me with this process. The decisions were not easy as the volume of creative energy present in your community is truly remarkable. Rockmart certainly has a talented colony of artisans and I look forward to future events."
